Denture Disaster Dodges

Lab 94 will be closed from 23rd December 2021 to 4th January 2022, so take extra care with your denture over the Christmas holidays by following these helpful tips...

- ✓ Avoid eating hard, sticky treats. Choose melt-in-your-mouth chocolates instead.
- ✓ Dentures are often lost down the loo, so always check your mouth before you flush.
- ✓ A loose denture is likely to fall out and break. Book an appointment with your dentist to refit loose dentures.
- ✓ Keep your denture out of reach of dogs. They are attracted to scent and think it is a treat.
- ✓ Never use glue to repair a denture. It will cause further damage to the denture and your oral tissues. We cannot repair a denture that has been super-glued together.
- ✓ Keep your previous denture handy or have a spare made, as a Plan B.
