Mornings are hectic so build up a pattern of breakfast and brushing. For the first few weeks until the habit is formed, pop a sticky note reminder on the door to read before leaving the house.

Snacks your child has at school have a big impact their teeth, so avoid sugary treats. Carrot sticks, apples and celery help remove plaque. Strawberries contains malic acid, which could help remove any stains on teeth.

Water after meals and throughout the day is important because it helps remove food from the teeth and will help keep the gums healthy.

After-School snacks are fine, then encourage your child to brush straight after to make sure the food from the school day is cleaned away.
