The facility includes a CBCT (Cone Beam Computed Tomography) scanner to produce precise, high resolution 3D images of a patient's mouth including the teeth, jaws, soft tissue and bones. **"We are a progressive practice that understands the importance of investing in our patients"** explains Clinical Director Dr Dan Naylor "and are one of only a handful of practices across North Wales able to offer this technology". Digital scanning is invaluable when working with complex cases and surgical procedures such as dental implant placement and bone augmentation. It is also a useful diagnostic tool for orthodontics, endodontics and periodontal treatments with images comparable to medical CT scans.
